## Lent

Lent commences on Sunday March 1st this year. All Christians acknowledge this each year because it has a special meaning for us.


What is Lent? It is a time when we remember when Jesus was thirty years old and He was baptized and anointed by God. Jesus then had to show that He would not commit any sins or do anything wrong. So for forty days Jesus "fasted". "Fasting" is when we do not have as much to eat as we usually do.

When Jesus, because He was a Jew, went into the desert, He was not allowed to take any food with him. He had to rely only on what He found growing or provided for Him. We know that in the desert there is not much food growing so He did not have much to eat and would have been very hungry. Imagine if we had to rely on what we found growing, we sure would be hungry too.


Satan is very cunning and sneaky. He thought that now was a good time to make Jesus commit a sin. He told Jesus to make some stones into bread. Jesus knew that He could do this, but He knew that if He did, He would be giving in to Satan and He relied on God to make Him strong. Satan tried everything to make Jesus do something wrong but he could not. Satan left Jesus and God sent Angels to care for Him.


Many people still "fast" during Lent by not eating some foods for forty days, but God wants us to do something better, something special. God wants us to stop committing sins. We commit sins when we do something we should not do, like being disobedient, swearing, being nasty or stealing. Also when we do not do something God wants us to, like caring for others, going to church, saying our prayers and trusting God.

During Lent we should try to be like our Lord and make a special effort to try and not do the things Satan wants us to. Remember, we can ask God to help us, and we should try to continue this during the year.

## How to make a palm cross

- 1 Take a palm that is about 2 feet long and 1/2" wide (if it tapers at the top, this is good). Hold the palm upright, so the tapered end points toward the ceiling.
- 2 Then bend the top end down and toward you
- 3 About a third of the way from the bend you just made, bend and crease palm diagonally
- 4 About an inch away from the stem of the cross, bend the palm back behind the stem so that it is now facing to your left. Make the bend at a good length to form the right arm of the cross.
- 5 Fold that same section at a point that equals the length on the right side, bend it on the left side and bring the end forward.
- 6 From the center of the cross, fold to the upper right so that it can wrap around where the "stem" and the right arm intersect.
- 7 Fold down and to the left behind the cross ...
- 8 and then fold it toward the right so that it is parallel and under the arms of the cross.
- 9 Bring it up behind the cross again, this time folding it up toward the northwest direction.
- 10 Tuck in the end to finish
- 11 Turn over!
