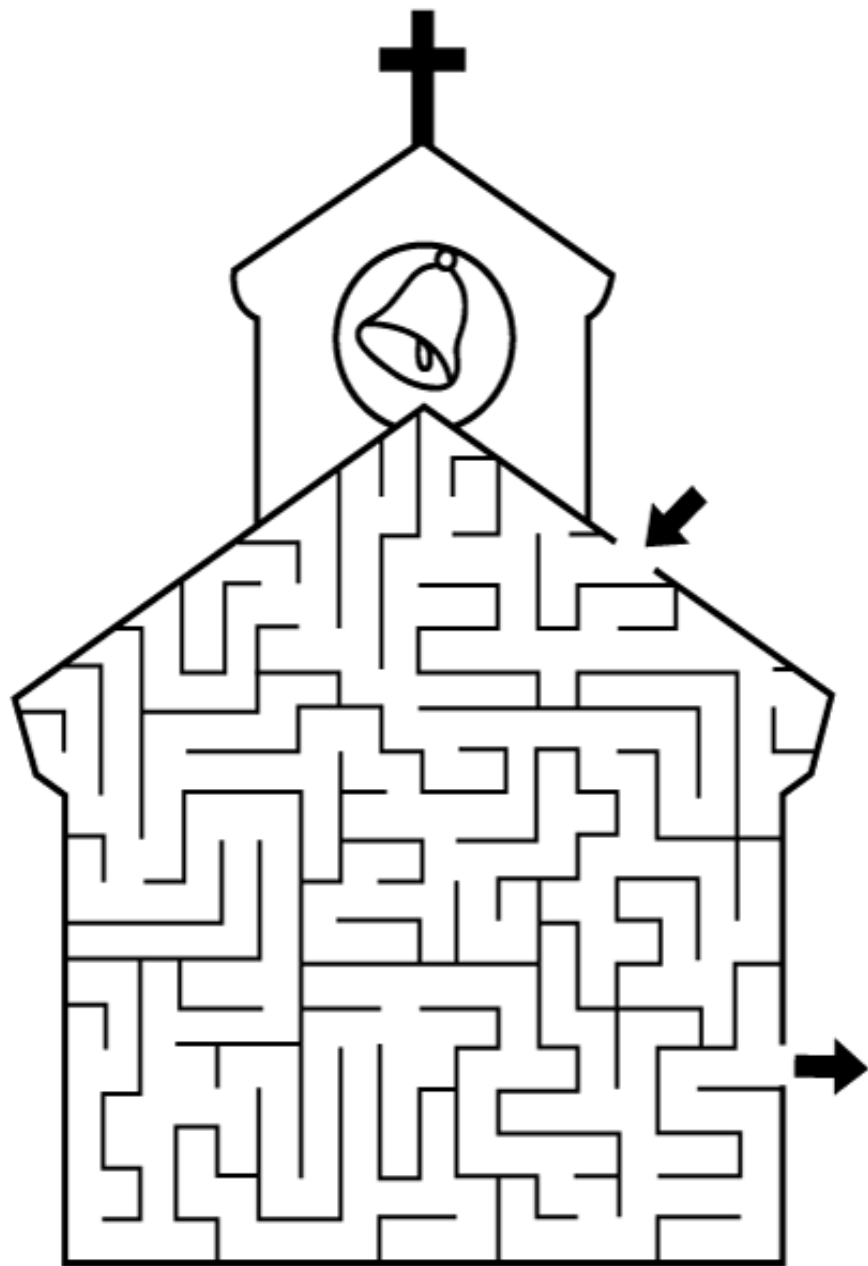

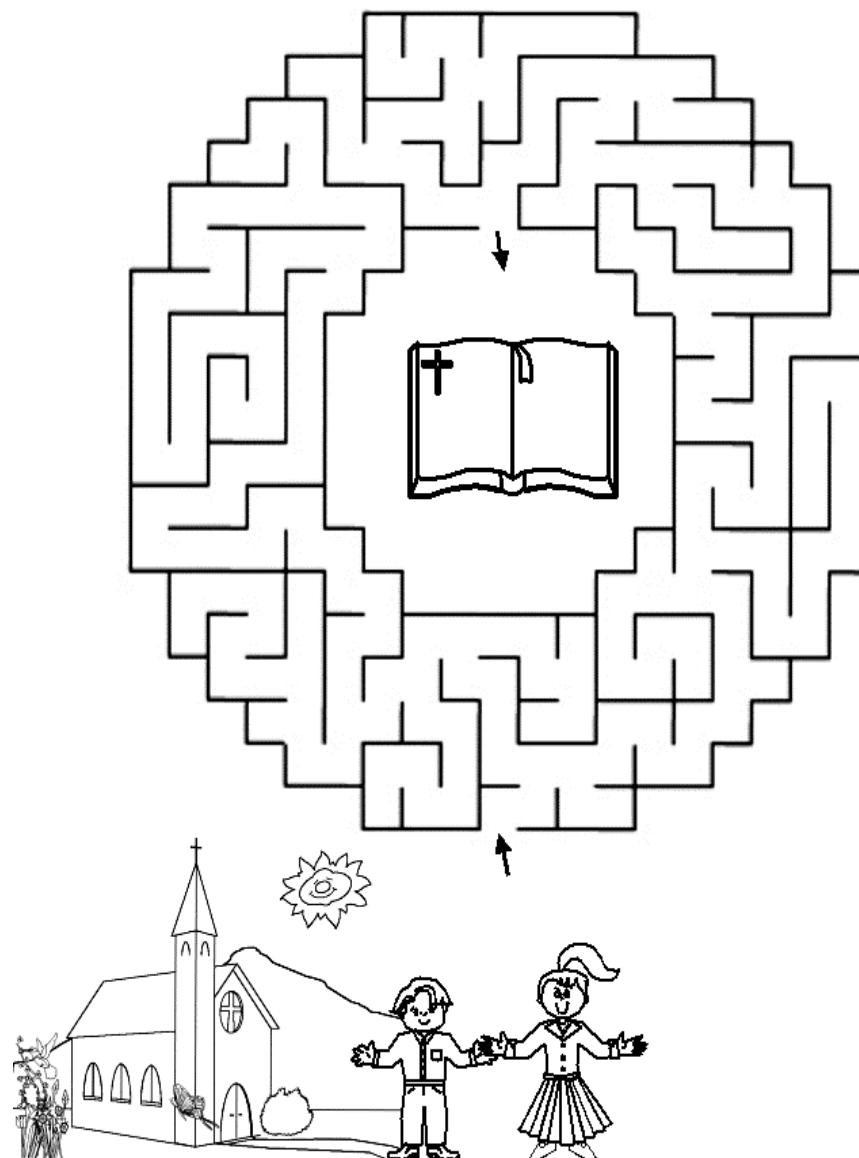

Colour in the Family



The Family Home

God loves us and wants to bless us. The Bible tells us that God's Word and blessing should be part of our home life.

Deuteronomy 11:20-21 "And thou shalt write them upon the door posts of thine house, and upon thy gates: That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children in the land which the Lord swore unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth."

The Jewish people had many troubles so having a place to rest, eat, talk and pray together was very important to them—a home. A home could be anything, even a tent. What made it a home was being with loved ones and with God.

Our homes can be a house, a caravan, a tent. They can be rented or owned. Our family may be our parents, grandparents or anyone who cares for us. It is love and

having God that makes this a "family home".

Things we can do to make sure God is in our home, and it is a family home are

- Pray when we wake up.
- Pray when we go to sleep.
- Eat together at the family table.
- Talk and pray together at the family table.
- Read the Bible and Catechism as a family.
