Then the road to failure is what these words will bring.

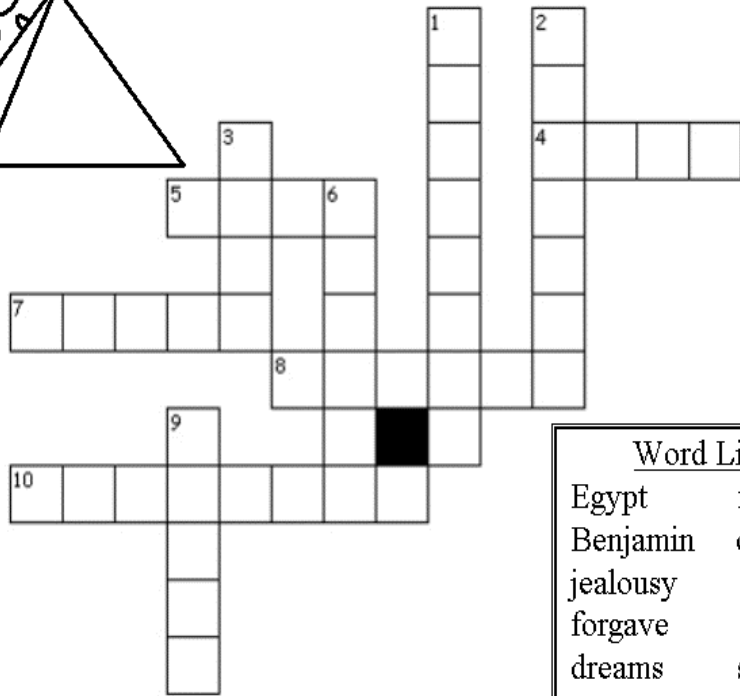
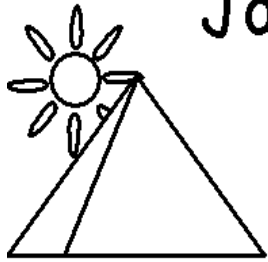

The Crow and the Fox



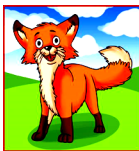
One day a big, black crow found some cheese. “I will fly up into this tree with it,” she said. “I want to eat it now.”

BEWARE OF PEOPLE WHO MAY SAY NICE THINGS WHICH THEY DO NOT MEAN!

BE CAREFUL, LITTLE TONGUE, WHAT YOU SAY

What does the Bible say about controlling our tongue?

The Old Testament warns us about avoiding gossip and evil speaking. *Proverbs 20:19 “He that goeth about as a talebearer revealeth secrets: Therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips.”*

The New Testament tells us to put away the wicked use of the tongue. *Ephesians 4:31 “Let all bitterness and wrath, and anger, and clamour and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice.”*

Why is an uncontrolled tongue so dangerous?

- Because words rashly spoken can have serious consequences.

Read Mark 6:22-28. It was because of rash speaking that King Herod ended up having John the Baptist beheaded, even though Herod did not want it done.

- Because it will affect the lives of individuals for a lifetime.

It hurts the person you are talking about, his/her family, friends, neighbours etc. It can affect them for a lifetime.

- A man who has an uncontrolled tongue brings pain and hurt upon himself.

1 Peter 3:10 “ For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile.”

Let us, every day, be very careful what our tongue speaks! The uncontrolled tongue is especially harmful and dangerous to the body of Jesus Christ.
