DOT-TO-DOT

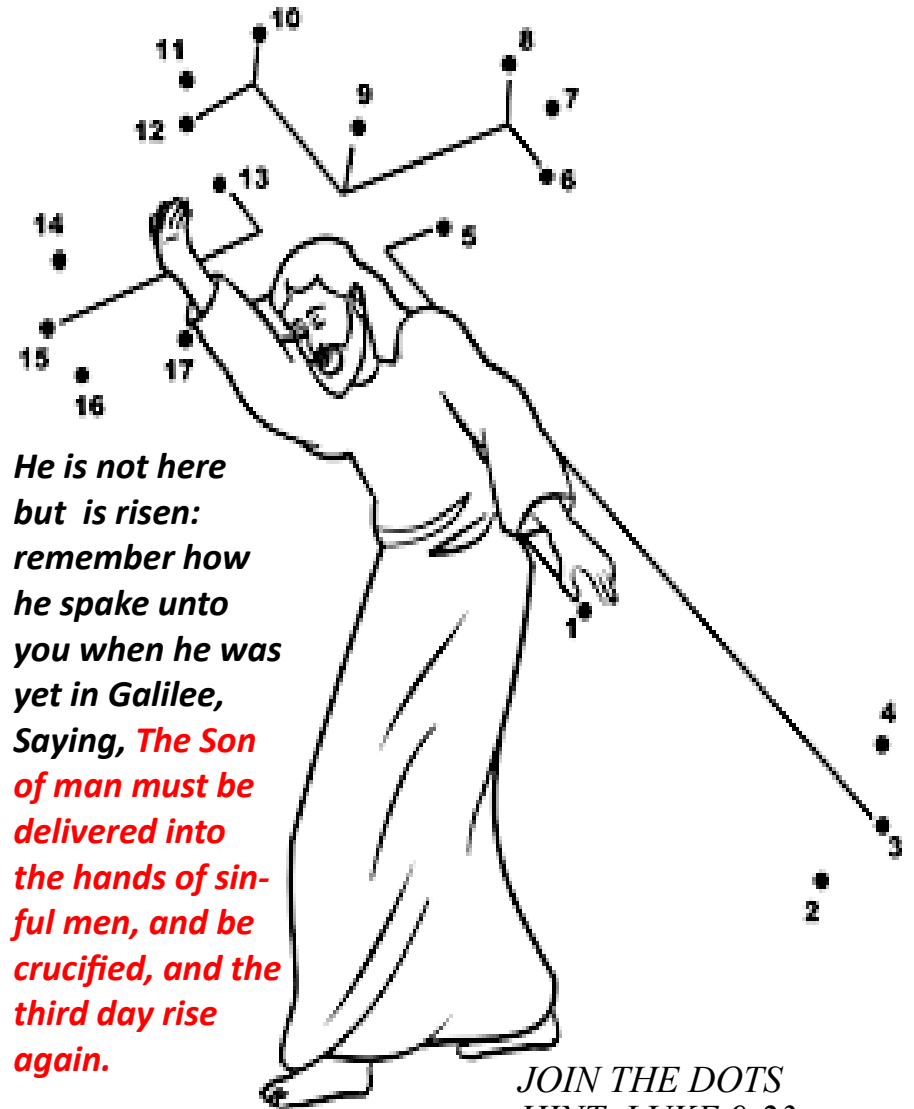
